

#### **SCHOOL OF LAW (SoL)**

CPJ School of Law offers 5 year integrated B.A.LL.B(H) & BBA LL.B(H) and 1 year LL.M Law programme. Approved by the Bar Council of India (BCI), the Law School's teaching standards and research quality consistently receive high ratings and it maintains a strong research culture.

**B.A.LL.B(H) programme** is running in CPJ School of Law since 2008. The course, as prescribed by GGSIPU, the affiliating University, is a combination of B.A. (Bachelor of Arts) and LL.B subjects. In the first two years, B.A.LL.B covers subjects like Political Science, Economics and Sociology etc. as well as specialized Law subjects such as Tax Laws, Criminal Laws and Corporate Laws etc.

**BBA LL.B(H) programme** was initiated by GGSIPU in the year 2014. It is a combination of BBA and LL.B subjects where in the first two years, BBA subjects are pre-dominant like Finance, Human Resource Management, International Business and Corporate Laws along with specialized Law subjects. From the 3<sup>rd</sup> year onwards, the curriculum of both the courses is the same.

**LL.M** 1 year post graduate Law programme has commenced from A.S. 2022 at the CPJ School of Law, as per UGC guidelines & affiliated to GGSIPU, Delhi. The vision of this program is to impart excellence in some specialised areas of legal education and be a renowned centre for higher education & academic research.

The LL.M course is being conducted with specializations in Criminal Justice System, Corporate Law and Alternative Dispute Resolution.

- Legal Aid Cell has been set up in the college wherein the para legal volunteers of School of Law, selected by Delhi Legal Services Authorities provide necessary guidance for free legal aid to the needy people. Literacy/Aid camps & rallies are regularly organized by the cell for the same.




